VISITING PROJECT COORDINATOR

The Ethnography of the University Initiative (EUI) is looking for a Coordinator who will lead the program in its mission to promote ethnographic research on the university and to make that research available in a web-based archive. The position offers a full-time, 12-month, non-tenure track appointment as an academic professional in the Department of Anthropology, University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. The initial appointment is for one year with a possibility of renewal for one year dependent upon funding. The position will be available as soon as possible after the closing date.

A pedagogical and research project, EUI operates both as a clearinghouse for student-generated ethnographic research on the university, and as a coordinator of special-topic collaborative research projects on the university. EUI has also worked to extend its reach beyond UIUC to other institutions of public higher education. Duties include maintaining the EUI website (www.eotu.uiuc.edu), overseeing EUI's involvement in the iLabs project (ilabs.inquiry.uiuc.edu); training and supporting faculty and students in EUI-affiliated courses; supervising EUI-affiliated projects and interns; participating in applying for external funding; and offering public presentations on EUI.

The successful candidate will have experience working with faculty and administrators in a college or university setting, demonstrate broad interest in higher education, and possess excellent written and oral communication skills. A Bachelor's degree is required, and a Master's degree is preferred. The enthusiasm and interpersonal skills needed to work with students and faculty are essential. Experience in web authoring and publishing (especially using Macromedia Dreamweaver) is highly desirable.

Salary is competitive and will be commensurate with experience and qualifications. Generous vacation/sick leave/paid holidays. State Retirement System. State sponsored health, dental, vision and life insurance.
